Drug-laced chocolates

The Hyderabad Police arrested a man on the charges of illegally possessing and selling marijuana laced chocolates near the Secunderabad railway station on Thursday. Officials seized about 24 kg drug-laced chocolate packets, worth about 1 lakh were seized from him. The drug peddler, identified as Gorakh Kumar from Uttar Pradesh, has been illegally smuggling drugs laced chocolates from Rajasthan to Hyderabad. He sold them for higher rates to consumers in the city. On Thursday, he reached railway station with the chocolates. He was apprehended by the police while he was waiting for a bus to deliver these chocolates to a shop in Kukatpally.

Treatment cost high for GBS

Ranges from Rs 4-5 lakh, say experts

Guillain Barre Syndrome (GBS) is a treatable disease! However, the cost of treating GBS patients is on a higher side, ranging from Rs 4 lakh to Rs 5 lakh. The costs could even escalate further, as 20 to 25 percent of GBS patients need ventilator support, which is prohibitively expensive in private hospitals in Hyderabad.

Since the treatment also includes a lot of rehabilitation, ventilator support and even physical disability, individuals with medical insurance will struggle with their out-of-pocket expenditure.

Senior neurologist from Hyderabad, Dr Sudhir Kumar, well known on social media platform X (@hyderabaddoctor) for his public health advisories, pointed out that Government help would be needed for such individuals. As for the actual treatment and

costs, based on set guidelines, Dr Sudhir Kumar points out that immunotherapy should be the preferred choice of treatment for doctors. "Immunotherapy through Intravenous Globulins (IVIG) is the drug of choice for treatment of GBS. The total dose is 2 grams per kilogram of body weight, which is split into 5 days, and given as infusion," he advises.

For example, for a patient weighing 60 kilograms, the total required dose would be 120 grams (60 multiplied by 2). This dose would be split into 5 days (25 grams each on day 1 to day 4, and

20 grams on day 5), he said. The IVIG injections are sold in two dose forms including 5 grams and 10 grams vials with cost of each vial ranging from Rs 15,000 to Rs 20,000 approximately. "So, the total cost of IVIG alone would be about Rs 2,50,000 to Rs 3,00,000 for one patient," Dr Sudhir points out.

Apart from the medicines, the GBS treatment also includes hospital stay, ICU care and ventilation, in case it is needed for patients.

"After discharge from the hospital, most patients have to undergo physiotherapy for 2-3 months for optimum recovery. This cost also needs to be factored in. So, the overall cost for treating a person with GBS is likely to be Rs 4 to Rs 5 lakh," Dr Sudhir said.

Apart from all this, indirect costs including loss of income from job due to illness and physical disability (for at least 1 to 3 months) will be additional.

Congress, BRS workers clash at Malkajgiri MRO

Mild tension prevailed at Malkajgiri Mandal Revenue Office (MRO) on Friday when supporters of Congress and BRS clashed during the distribution of 'Kalyana Lakshmi' and 'Shaadi Mubarak' cheques to beneficiaries.

The incident occurred during an event to distribute the cheques, which was organised by Malkajgiri MLA Marri Rajasekhara Reddy in the presence of Malkajgiri MRO Sitaram.

During the cheque distribution event, BRS leaders and party workers demanded that the State government fulfil its promise of distributing one tola of gold along with the cheque of Rs one lakh, as promised during elections and raised slogans against Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy and the Congress party.

Police takes control

The protests led to an argument between BRS and Congress activists. A scuffle broke out between the two groups that eventually led to a clash. The police intervened and pacified both the groups and brought the situation under control.

Osmania General Hospital at glance

ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY

- Actual construction of OGH heritage structure started in 1920 and was completed by 1925

Two women live with mom's body for 9 days

In a heart wrenching incident in Warasiguda, Secunderabad, grief-stricken by their mother's death, two young women reportedly lived with her lifeless body for nine days in their home.

The woman Sri Lalitha (45) was staying in a rented house at Road number 3, Warasiguda, Secunderabad, along with her two daughters Ravalika (25) and Ashwitha (22).

About nine days ago, Sri Lalitha died under suspicious circumstances. However, her two daughters, who were upset over their mother's death did not leave the body or the house and instead chose to stay with it for the next eight days, police said.

It is learnt that the two young women also tried to end their lives by cutting their wrists, but were unsuccessful.

The incident came to light on Friday when the neighbours sensed foul smell emanating from the house and informed the local police. On the directions of Secunderabad MLA T Padmarao Goud, the police rescued the two women and shifted them to the police station. Based on their complaint, the Warasiguda police have booked a suspicious death case and took up investigation.

The reason for Sri Lalitha's death is yet to be known. The highly decomposed body was shifted to the Gandhi Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Unemployed youth protest at OU campus

With a slogan 'Congress party Hatao, Job Calendar Bachao', unemployed youth vowed to campaign against the grand-old party in the ensuing MLC and local body elections in the State.

"The unemployed youth will ensure that Congress does not get a single vote in the local body elections as it failed to release the job notifications as assured," said Mothilal Naik, leader of OU JAC.

The unemployed youth, along with Osmania University (OU) students, staged a protest demanding the State government release the job calendar and recruitment notifications at OU Main Library here on Friday. The protesters wanted notifications for 12,000 VRO, 1,000 deputy surveyor, 10,000 power sector, DSC and Group - I, II and III vacancies.

Stating that they were silent due to SC sub-classification and BC reservation implementation issue, the Naik said the unemployed youth would now be staging indefinite rallies, demanding the release of job notifications.

Criticising the State government's decision to enhance universities teaching staff superannuation age to 65 years, Naik demanded immediate revocation of the decision.

1,190 phones worth over Rs 3.5 cr recovered

The Cyberabad Police have recovered a total of 1,190 mobile phones worth Rs 3.5 crore, which were either stolen or lost in the last 50 days. The Central Crime Station officials recovered 1,010 mobile phones out of the 1,190, while the remaining 180 phones were recovered by the law and order police using the Central Equipment Identity Register (CEIR) portal.

The recovered phones were handed over to their owners in an event held at the Cyberabad Police Commissionerate. DCP (Crimes) K Narasimha highlighted the importance of avoiding the purchase/sale of stolen items, as it is a punishable offense.

"Protect your belongings and remain vigilant. Cyber-crimes are increasing, with fraudsters using tactics such as inappropriate video calls to blackmail individuals," he warned. He encouraged citizens to report lost or stolen phones at their nearest police station or through the CEIR portal.
