**Man booked for hatred**  
The Madhuranagar police booked a case against a person for allegedly promoting enmity between two groups following a petty quarrel over parking of a scooter on a road. A man who was going on the road at Yellareddyguda in Madhuranagar, noticed a two-wheeler parked on the road. "He objected to the parking of the vehicle and asked the owner to remove it. Heated arguments ensued between them during which the suspect said he would shut all loud speakers of a place of prayer once the Congress government comes to power," said an official.

**Bike thefts: 3 arrested**  
Kacheguda police apprehended three, including two juveniles, for their alleged involvement in bike theft cases reported in different parts of the city. The police recovered 14 motorcycles from them. The two juveniles, who are natives of Medak district, committed theft of 14 two-wheelers in different parts of Hyderabad in a span of two months and sold it to one G Laxman alias Raju at throwaway price, said Kacheguda ACP A Srinivas Rao. On a tip-off, the police caught them and recovered the property.

**Ganja smuggling**  
An SUV that was carrying nearly 2 quintals of dry ganja met with an accident at Buchenelly in Zaheerabad. The car, which was being driven at high speed, turned turtle after the driver reportedly lost control over the steering. The ganja packets were thrown out of the vehicle in the impact. Chiragally police seized the vehicle and the ganja. Two persons, who were traveling in the vehicle, reportedly escaped. The police were trying to trace them based on the vehicle's registration number. The ganja was reportedly being smuggled from Odisha border to Mumbai when the accident occurred.

# Police ready with three-tier security

Only designated persons to be allowed into counting centres

Elaborate security arrangements have been made by the police at the centres in the city where counting of votes will be taken up on Sunday. Senior officials of the tri-commissionerates of Hyderabad, Rachakonda and Cyberabad visited these counting centres on Saturday and reviewed the security arrangements in coordination with local election authorities.

The police will ensure three-layered security at the counting centres and only designated people will be allowed into the centre after verifying their credentials. After analysing the situation on election day, the police have drafted their action plan and will be deploying forces accordingly. "The activities in and around the counting centres will be monitored from the command and control centres. Drone patrolling will also be done wherever necessary," said Hyderabad Police Commissioner Sandeep Shandilya. The police identified a few constituencies including Jubilee Hills, Nampally, Khairatabad, Yakutpura, Malakpet, Malkajigiri, Medchal, Ibrahimpatnam and LB Nagar for more deployment of forces. An official of DCP rank will be present at the counting centre to supervise security arrangements both inside and outside the counting centre. Central Armed Police Force, Rapid Action Force, Telangana State Special Police and local police will be deployed at the counting centre to respond to any law and order situation. Quick Action Teams will be deployed in certain Assembly constituencies.

## Cellphones strictly prohibited, says Rose

**HYDERABAD:** Elaborate arrangements have been put in place at centres where counting of votes of 15 Assembly constituencies is to be taken up on Sunday, said Hyderabad District Election Officer and GHMC Commissioner Ronald Rose. Starting with Wesley College Ground for Secunderabad Cantonment, Rose on Saturday visited the counting centre to review the preparations. Along with Hyderabad Police Commissioner Sandeep Shandilya, he also inspected counting centres at AV College, GHMC Indoor Stadium, Raja Bahadur Venkat Rama Reddy College for Women, Prof G Ram Reddy Centre for Distance Education, and Osmania University College of Commerce and Business Management. Stating that cell phones are strictly prohibited inside the counting centres, Rose asked counting staff and agents to be present at the centres by 5 am. A total of 14 tables have been set up

for counting in a grilled area, with seating provided for representatives of political parties and media. At 8 am on Sunday, the officials will begin counting votes of postal ballots. From 9 am onwards, votes on EVMs will be counted with results of the first round likely to be announced at 9.30 am. General Observers appointed by the Election Commission of India will be present for the entire counting process which is expected to be completed by late evening.

## Seizures up 454% in 2023 polls

**HYDERABAD:** During the Telangana Assembly elections 2023 phase, the State police registered a 454 per cent increase in seizures of cash, precious metals, drugs, liquor and freebies as compared to elections in 2018. In 2018 elections, the Telangana police seized Rs 103 crore of property including Rs 97 crore in cash while in 2023 elections, the total amount of property seized is Rs 469 crore including Rs 241.52 crore in cash. In the last 50 days, the police seized Rs 241.52 crore cash, gold and silver worth Rs 175.95 crore, liquor worth Rs 13.36 crore, drugs worth Rs 22.17 crore and freebies worth Rs 16.63 crore, said Telangana DGP Anjani Kumar. The police booked 11,859 FIRs from October 9 to December 1. Anjani Kumar said the seniors and younger officials contributed best of their ability and carried forward the entire team.

## Three drug peddlers nabbed

The Telangana State Anti-Narcotics Bureau along with Suraram police nabbed three persons who were allegedly selling drugs on Saturday. The police seized 60 grams crystal methamphetamine, 700 ml liquid methamphetamine and acetone bottle containing 150 ml of the liquid. The arrested persons are Kamma Srinivas alias Srinu (40), G Narsimha Raju (42) and D Manikanta Veera Nagaraju (32), all natives of Andhra Pradesh.

**Set up unit**  
According to the police, Srinivas, Raju and Nagaraju procured the equipment needed for preparing drugs and set up a unit in Suraram where they started preparing crystal methamphetamine from its liquid form. On information, the TSNAB raided the place and caught them. A case was registered against them at Suraram police station. The prime suspect Srinivas was previously arrested by the Hyderabad Narcotics Control Bureau in 2013 when he was manufacturing methamphetamine drug at an industrial area in Jeedimetla. After release on bail in November 2017, he again started his activities after coming in contact with Raju and Nagaraju, the officials said. The police requested parents to keep a tab on their children. The police asked the citizens to inform police on 8712671111, or any information pertaining to the drugs.
